

Notice of Public Meeting Assessment of Fair Housing

The City of Dallas in coordination with the Dallas Housing Authority will hold a Public meeting in each of the 14 Dallas council member districts during the month of July 2017. A schedule identifying the date and location of each public meeting is attached and available at www.dhadal.com. The meeting scheduled to occur Saturday, July 29, 2017, from 10:00 am to noon will be held at the Roseland Homes Recreation Center located at 1949 N. Washington Avenue, Dallas, Texas 75204. Each of the meetings is intended to inform residents about the Assessment of Fair Housing (AFH) and provide an opportunity for all to participate in the AFH planning process.

The Assessment of Fair Housing (AFH) is a legal requirement that the City and Dallas Housing Authority must complete in order to continue receiving federal housing and community development funding from the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD). The AFH is an analysis undertaken pursuant to 24 CFR Part 5.152 that includes an analysis of fair housing data, an assessment of housing issues and contributing factors, and identification of fair housing priorities and goals specific to Dallas, Texas. Examples of fair housing issues include local and regional demographics related to segregation, racially and ethnically concentrated areas of poverty, access to opportunity, disproportionate housing need, publicly supported housing, accesses to housing by persons with disabilities, and fair housing enforcement.

Residents, businesses, nonprofit organizations and churches in Dallas and surrounding communities are encouraged to attend and provide input. Anyone unable to attend a meeting, may make their views known by submitting written comments to the Dallas Housing Authority, Fair Housing Officer, 3939 N.
