Phoenix Rising Scholarship

The Dallas Housing Authority (DHA) encourages academic excellence, high self-esteem, positive self-image outstanding leadership and community involvement among our students. Many of our residents need assistance in continuing their pursuit of a higher education. The Phoenix- Rising Scholarship Award has been implemented for college students who are returning to school after a separation of at least two years, to help off set some of the cost of the student's education. In order to be considered for a scholarship a student must be in compliance and comply with the following criteria:

Eligibility

- A student must reside in Public or Section 8 Housing.
- A student must be attend a (2) hour "Getting Started Again" workshop
- Must apply for financial aid
- Must show proof of paid application/registration fee

How to Apply

All candidates for DHA Phoenix Fund Scholarship must submit a completed Phoenix Fund Scholarship Packet including:

- Proof of registration (i.e. class schedule, fee receipt or letter from institution)
- Address & telephone number of the institution of higher learning (please specify the department that the scholarship will be disbursed to, i.e. financial aid office, bursars office, business office etc.)
- Students address and telephone number on campus
- Submit a typed essay of 300-word essay on:

"Who or What has influenced you to Return to School?"

Application must be postmarked by Friday, September 19, 2014
